Evergreen ornamental grasses in a range of colours – blue, bronze/brown, green, yellow and white variation (Spring collection) selected for foliage, texture and colour.

Grasses will tolerate a huge range of conditions, and are low maintenance. They can be used as single architectural plants, in drifts with perennials or in containers.

They have become very popular since the turn of the century. The current trend is to plant them in natural drifts with perennials (Prairie planting).
